| 10 |  | <p>Seiger Semi-Determinate</p> <p>Organic Seiger Tomato offers incredible amounts of delectable 4-ounce bright red fruits, early even in cool seasons and she produces for weeks after other varieties had succumbed to a number of diseases, including Late Blight, Early Blight and Septoria.</p> |
| 11 |  | <p>Tomatoberry Indeterminate</p> <p>Unique strawberry-shaped fruits. High-yielding plants. Deep red fruits have broad shoulders which taper to a blunt point at the blossom end, giving them a heart-like appearance. Firm, meaty texture with excellent sweet flavor. Fruits avg. 1" x 1"</p> |

| 13 |  | <p>Pienollo del Vesuvio</p> <p>Semi-Determinate</p> <p>Organic Piennolo Del Vesuvio Paste Tomato is early to mature in short seasons. They are the beloved 'hanging tomato of Vesuvius,' an heirloom selected for centuries in Italy's volcanic soils. Pienollo has phenomenally low water content as a paste tomato & fairly thick skins allow them to be hung, traditionally, for months indoors to extend the season. Their concentrated flavor after even one month of hanging is heavenly.</p> |
| 14 |  | <p>Striped German</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>The flat, medium to large tomatoes with variable shoulder ribbing are shaded yellow and red.</p> |
| 15 |  | <p>Yellow Pear</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Distinctive petite salad tomato. The tall, vigorous vines bear quantities of small, 3/4–1 oz., lemon yellow, pear-shaped fruits. Mild flavor.</p> |
| 16 |  | <p>Pineapple</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Combination of orange and yellow stripes both inside and out. Very large, beefsteak type fruits are 5 inches in diameter with juicy, meaty flesh, and a fine mild flavor.</p> |

| <p>18</p> |  | <p>Kellogg's Breakfast Tomato</p> <p>A beautiful orange beefsteak. Its fruit is very flavorful and superbly sweet! This delicious heirloom originated in West Virginia.</p> |
| <p>19</p> |  | <p>Gold Medal Indeterminate</p> <p>The 1-3 lb fruit is a smooth and bi-colored tomato. Yellow fruit is blushing with rosy red that radiates from the blossom end.</p> |
| <p>20</p> |  | <p>Sart Roloise</p> <p>These gorgeous globes have the lustre and stunning color of a stained glass masterpiece. The Sart Roloise tomato is bursting with sweet, fruity and complex flavor with just the right acidity, owing its tropical flavor profile to its parentage. It is a cross of the White Wonder tomato, which lends pineapple sweet notes, and the Baby Blue tomato, which explains the deep indigo blue brushstrokes on the shoulders! This variety was bred in Belgium. This is a large beefsteak type. The big, beautiful fruit averages 10-20 ounces each.</p> |
| <p>21</p> |  | <p>Armenian Organic</p> <p>Heirloom originally from Armenia . An indeterminate that produces large, 1-lb., lightly ribbed, yellow and orange beefsteak tomato with some red marbling. Unusually strong flavors for a bi-colored.</p> |

| 22 |  | <p>Canestrino</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Meaning Little Basket, Canestrino is a tasty Italian heirloom from Tuscany with a plump red body and slender green-yellow shoulders. Its slightly ribbed, pear-shaped fruits weigh in at just 8 ounces and are best picked when slightly green for the most flavorful gourmet taste. Canestrino is also a top pick for Tomato paste.</p> |
| 23 |  | <p>Hungarian Heart</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Brilliant reddish-pink oxheart type fruit is large—frequently exceeding one pound! The fruit of this heirloom is firm and meaty like all oxheart types—great for paste, canning or fresh use. The crack-resistant fruit contains very few seeds and shows very little tendency to develop cores. Heavy production all season long. Originated outside of Budapest, Hungary, around 1900.</p> |
| 24 |  | <p>Amish Paste</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>A longtime favorite heirloom plum. Large for a sauce tomato, Amish Paste's slightly irregular plum to strawberry-shaped fruits avg. 8-12 oz. with excellent flavor. These meaty tomatoes are good in salads and great for processing.</p> |
| 25 |  | <p>Martino's Roma Tomato</p> <p>Determinate.</p> <p>Fantastic yields of richly flavorful plum-shaped tomatoes, on compact plants that require very little staking! Resistant to early blight, reliable for home or market gardens! The paste-type fruit weighs in at 2-3 ounces, dry-fleshed and very meaty with few seeds. Great for sauces, salsas and pastes.</p> |

Because of its scalloped edges, perfect for use in an arrangement of different colored sliced tomatoes. Costoluto Genovese has been favored by generations of chefs in Italy and America for its rich flavors for wonderful pungent pasta sauce.
