1		<p><b>Rutgers 100 seeds</b></p> <p>Determinate</p> <p>Uniform 7 ounce fruits are a brilliant red with a terrific full bodied flavor. A Jersey heirloom tomato.</p>
2		<p><b>Rose de Berne 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Rich brandy-wine like Swiss heirloom.</p>
3		<p><b>Moskvich 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Johnny's Seeds fruits are early, deep red, and cold tolerant. Rich flavor. Smooth and globe-shaped. 4-6 oz.</p>
4		<p><b>Cosmonaut Volkov 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Semi Determinate</p> <p>Wins every taste competition with its rich complex flavor! Sweet and tangy fruits are slightly flattened with a healthy red color and moderately green shoulders. Originally from Ukraine. Produces high yields even in cool conditions.</p>

5		<p><b>Greek Domata 20-25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>From Athos, Greece. An 8-12 oz., 3-inch slicer with excellent sweet, well-balanced flavors. A well-revered tomato!</p>
6		<p><b>Greek Rose 20-25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Originally from Crete. Large, 16 oz., beautiful, pink tomato. BIG, complex flavors. Good sandwich tomato. Stunning! RARE.</p>
7		<p><b>Brandywine 50 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Amish heirloom. Exceptionally rich-tasting, the slightly flattened fruits grow to 6" to 7" in diameter.</p>
8		<p><b>Favorite 20-25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Introduced by Livingston Seed Co. in 1883. Indeterminate, regular leaf very productive plant produces big bunches of 10-12 oz., smooth, bright-red fruits. An American favorite.</p>

9		<p><b>Thessaloniki 15-20 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Greek heirloom tomato. Introduced to the USA in the 1950's by Glecklers Seedsmen of Ohio. Exceptionally good yields of crack-free, red, 8 oz. globes that resist sun scald. Wonderful rich taste. Disease resistant. A popular market tomato.</p>
10		<p><b>Sweet Israeli 20-25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Determinate</p> <p>Bushy, regular leaf plant produce abundant crop of luscious, 2"-3" inch, brilliant red tomatoes from Israel.</p>
11		<p><b>Ukrainian Heirloom (Black Ethiopian) 40-50 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Originally from the Ukraine region. Our Organic tomato seeds produce vigorous indeterminate, regular-leaf tomato plants that yield copious amounts of red-mahogany-bronze, 5-oz., plum-shaped fruit. Exceptional, rich, fruity, tangy taste. Rare tomato seeds.</p>
12		<p><b>Berkeley Pink Tie Dye 40 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic and compact indeterminate</p> <p>8-12 oz. fruits are dark pink with green striping, and the flesh is pink with yellow streaks. The flavor is outstanding - sweet and complex like the finest heirlooms.</p>

13		<p><b>Fox Cherry 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Prolific, delicious large, red heirloom cherry tomatoes with rich, full-bodied, mildly acidic flavor; one of the best-tasting large cherries. Easy to pick from long vines.</p>
14		<p><b>Sebastopol – 15-20 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>1900's heirloom. Indeterminate tomato plants that produce large, 3/4-inch, red cherry tomatoes that are sweet tasting with a spark of tart flavors. Sebastopol is well suited for cooler, coastal regions, or short season gardens and area's with foggy summer climates. A wonderful salad tomato or snacking tomato. Rare tomato seed.</p>
15		<p><b>Tomatoberry 15 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Unique strawberry-shaped fruits. High-yielding plants. Deep red fruits have broad shoulders which taper to a blunt point at the blossom end, giving them a heart-like appearance. Firm, meaty texture with excellent sweet flavor. Fruits avg. 1" x 1"</p>
16		<p><b>Santorini 20-25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>From the Greek island of Santorini, 1-2 oz., flattened, slightly-ribbed tomato with very good, slightly-acidic flavors. Perfect for canning.</p>

17		<p><b>Striped German 75 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>The flat, medium to large tomatoes with variable shoulder ribbing are shaded yellow and red.</p>
18		<p><b>Yellow Pear 50 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Distinctive petite salad tomato. The tall, vigorous vines bear quantities of small, 3/4–1 oz., lemon yellow, pear-shaped fruits. Mild flavor.</p>
19		<p><b>Pineapple 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Combination of orange and yellow stripes both inside and out. Very large, beefsteak type fruits are 5 inches in diameter with juicy, meaty flesh, and a fine mild flavor.</p>
20		<p><b>Big Rainbow 50 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Stunning shades of gold to scarlet and everything in between make this heirloom variety truly stand out. Giant fruits, up to 2 pounds, have a rich balance of acids and sugars that gives it a true old-fashioned tomato taste. Resistant to foliar disease and cracks.</p>

21		<p><b>Kellogg's Breakfast Tomato 15-20</b></p> <p>A beautiful orange beefsteak. Its fruit is very flavorful and superbly sweet! This delicious heirloom originated in West Virginia.</p>
22		<p><b>Dagma's Russian Yellow 15-20 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>A sport of the very popular Orange Russian 117 variety. Large, indeterminate plant produces an abundant crop of beautiful yellow beefsteak shaped 12-14 oz. deliciously sweet tomatoes.</p>
23		<p><b>Blush 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Indeterminate. A newer cultivar of tomato with beauty and flavor on one side, and vigorous plants bearing high-quality fruits on the other. Beautiful, elongated yellow fruits have a pearl-like iridescence, are very crack-resistant and have excellent field standing. Mini-saladette fruits are about 2-2.5 inches long.</p>
24		<p><b>Canestrino 50 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Meaning Little Basket, Canestrino is a tasty Italian heirloom from Tuscany with a plump red body and slender green-yellow shoulders. Its slightly ribbed, pear-shaped fruits weigh in at just 8 ounces and are best picked when slightly green for the most flavorful gourmet taste. Canestrino is also a top pick for Tomato paste.</p>

25		<p><b>Hungarian Heart 50 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Brilliant reddish-pink oxheart type fruit is large—frequently exceeding one pound! The fruit of this heirloom is firm and meaty like all oxheart types—great for paste, canning or fresh use. The crack-resistant fruit contains very few seeds and shows very little tendency to develop cores. Heavy production all season long. Originated outside of Budapest, Hungary, around 1900.</p>
26		<p><b>Amish Paste 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>A longtime favorite heirloom plum. Large for a sauce tomato, Amish Paste's slightly irregular plum to strawberry-shaped fruits avg. 8-12 oz. with excellent flavor. These meaty tomatoes are good in salads and great for processing.</p>
27		<p><b>Costoluto Genovese 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Italian heirloom tomato that has been enjoyed for many generations along the Mediterranean. Large, deep red fruits have a fluted proville, are deeply ridged and heavily lobed. Meaty, full-flavored, slightly tart and delicious. Favored by generations of chefs in Italy and America for its rich flavors for pungent pasta sauce.</p>
28		<p><b>San Marzano II 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>High-quality strain of this classic heirloom paste tomato. San Marzano is considered one of the best paste tomatoes of all time, with Old World look and taste. Whole 4–6 oz. tomatoes. The strain originates from Parma, Italy, where it was developed for the 1950's canning industry.</p>

29		<p><b>Opalka 25 seeds</b></p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Wispy vines of the Polish Opalka tomato yield great 3" by 6" red tomatoes. Perfect for processing thanks to the low amount of seeds contained within.</p>
30		<p><b>Black Beauty</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>A very dark meaty, very rich-fleshed tomato So dark that some tomatoes turn solid blue-black on the skin. The deep red flesh is rich, smooth, and savory with earthy tones.</p>
31		<p><b>Purple Calabash</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Stocky, ruffled fruit that provides a deliciously nuanced flavor experience. These medium-sized fruits reach about 3 inches across and 1.5 inches high, marbled pink to purple and chocolate in color. This variety is known to be a good representation of how tomatoes in Mexico looked and tasted before European colonization.</p>
32		<p><b>Queen of the Night</b></p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>From the Rhine region of Germany, this 3- to 3.5 ounce tomato has multi-color skin and red flesh that is fragrant, sweet, and loaded with tomato taste</p>

### **Ananas Noire (Black Pineapple)**

Indeterminate

From Belgium, this multi-colored tomato weighs about 1.5 pounds. The flesh is bright green with deep red streaks. Superb flavor which is both sweet and smoky with a hint of citrus. Heavy yield.
