1		<p>Rutgers</p> <p>Determinate</p> <p>Uniform 7 ounce fruits are a brilliant red with a terrific full bodied flavor. A Jersey heirloom tomato.</p>
2		<p>Rose de Berne</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Rich brandy-wine like Swiss heirloom.</p>
3		<p>Moskvich</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Johnny's Seeds fruits are early, deep red, and cold tolerant. Rich flavor. Smooth and globe-shaped. 4-6 oz.</p>
4		<p>Cosmonaut Volkov</p> <p>Semi Determinate</p> <p>Wins every taste competition with its rich complex flavor! Sweet and tangy fruits are slightly flattened with a healthy red color and moderately green shoulders. Originally from Ukraine. Produces high yields even in cool conditions.</p>

5		<p>Greek Domata</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>From Athos, Greece. An 8-12 oz., 3-inch slicer with excellent sweet, well-balanced flavors. A well-revered tomato!</p>
6		<p>Ukrainian Heirloom (Black Ethiopian)</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Originally from the Ukraine region. Our Organic tomato seeds produce vigorous indeterminate, regular-leaf tomato plants that yield copious amounts of red-mahogany-bronze, 5-oz., plum-shaped fruit. Exceptional, rich, fruity, tangy taste. Rare tomato seeds.</p>
7		<p>Fox Cherry</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Prolific, delicious large, red heirloom cherry tomatoes with rich, full-bodied, mildly acidic flavor; one of the best-tasting large cherries. Easy to pick from long vines.</p>
8		<p>Favorite</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Introduced by Livingston Seed Co. in 1883. Indeterminate, regular leaf very productive plant produces big bunches of 10-12 oz., smooth, bright-red fruits. An American favorite.</p>

9		<p>Porter's Dark Cherry</p> <p>Organic Heirloom Clusters of 6-10, plum-shaped tomatoes with good flavors for snacking, canning and juice. A long-season variety.</p>
10		<p>Tomatoberry</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Unique strawberry-shaped fruits. High-yielding plants. Deep red fruits have broad shoulders which taper to a blunt point at the blossom end, giving them a heart-like appearance. Firm, meaty texture with excellent sweet flavor. Fruits avg. 1" x 1"</p>
11		<p>Santorini</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>From the Greek island of Santorini, 1-2 oz., flattened, slightly-ribbed tomato with very good, slightly-acidic flavors. Perfect for canning.</p>
12		<p>Striped German</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>The flat, medium to large tomatoes with variable shoulder ribbing are shaded yellow and red.</p>

<p style="font-size: 24pt; font-weight: bold; margin: 0;">14</p>		<p>Pineapple</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Combination of orange and yellow stripes both inside and out. Very large, beefsteak type fruits are 5 inches in diameter with juicy, meaty flesh, and a fine mild flavor.</p>
<p style="font-size: 24pt; font-weight: bold; margin: 0;">15</p>		<p>Big Rainbow</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Stunning shades of gold to scarlet and everything in between make this heirloom variety truly stand out. Giant fruits, up to 2 pounds, have a rich balance of acids and sugars that gives it a true old-fashioned tomato taste. Resistant to foliar disease and cracks.</p>

<p style="font-size: 24pt; font-weight: bold; margin: 0;">17</p>		<p>Berkeley Pink Tie Dye</p> <p>Organic and compact indeterminate</p> <p>8-12 oz. fruits are dark pink with green striping, and the flesh is pink with yellow streaks. The flavor is outstanding - sweet and complex like the finest heirlooms.</p>

Large, indeterminate plant produces an abundant crop of beautiful yellow beefsteak shaped 12-14 oz. deliciously sweet tomatoes.</p>
<p style="font-size: 24pt; font-weight: bold; text-align: center;">19</p>		<p>Blush</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Indeterminate. A newer cultivar of tomato with beauty and flavor on one side, and vigorous plants bearing high-quality fruits on the other. Beautiful, elongated yellow fruits have a pearl-like iridescence, are very crack-resistant and have excellent field standing. Mini-saladette fruits are about 2-2.5 inches long.</p>
<p style="font-size: 24pt; font-weight: bold; text-align: center;">20</p>		<p>Canestrino</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Meaning Little Basket, Canestrino is a tasty Italian heirloom from Tuscany with a plump red body and slender green-yellow shoulders. Its slightly ribbed, pear-shaped fruits weigh in at just 8 ounces and are best picked when slightly green for the most flavorful gourmet taste. Canestrino is also a top pick for Tomato paste.</p>
<p style="font-size: 24pt; font-weight: bold; text-align: center;">21</p>		<p>Hungarian Heart</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Brilliant reddish-pink oxheart type fruit is large— frequently exceeding one pound! The fruit of this heirloom is firm and meaty like all oxheart types—great for paste, canning or fresh use. The crack-resistant fruit contains very few seeds and shows very little tendency to develop cores. Heavy production all season long. Originated outside of Budapest, Hungary, around 1900.</p>

22		<p>Amish Paste</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>A longtime favorite heirloom plum. Large for a sauce tomato, Amish Paste's slightly irregular plum to strawberry-shaped fruits avg. 8-12 oz. with excellent flavor. These meaty tomatoes are good in salads and great for processing.</p>
23		<p>Costoluto Genovese</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Italian heirloom tomato that has been enjoyed for many generations along the Mediterranean. Large, deep red fruits have a fluted profile, are deeply ridged and heavily lobed. Meaty, full-flavored, slightly tart and delicious. Favored by generations of chefs in Italy and America for its rich flavors for pungent pasta sauce.</p>
24		<p>San Marzano II</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>High-quality strain of this classic heirloom paste tomato. San Marzano is considered one of the best paste tomatoes of all time, with Old World look and taste. Whole 4–6 oz. tomatoes. The strain originates from Parma, Italy, where it was developed for the 1950's canning industry.</p>
25		<p>Opalka</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Wispy vines of the Polish Opalka tomato yield great 3" by 6" red tomatoes. Perfect for processing thanks to the low amount of seeds contained within.</p>

26		<p>Greek Rose</p> <p>Organic</p> <p>Originally from Crete. Large, 16 oz., beautiful, pink tomato. BIG, complex flavors. Good sandwich tomato. Stunning! RARE.</p>
27		<p>Prudens Purple</p> <p>Organic and Indeterminate</p> <p>Early Brandywine type. Large to very large (many over 1 lb.) fruits are flattened and smooth (except for shoulder ribbing on some), and resist cracking. Vivid dark-pink skin with crimson flesh. Medium-tall, potato-leaf plants.</p>
28		<p>Druzba</p> <p>Indeterminate</p> <p>Large heirloom beefsteak-style from Bulgaria. Druzba means friendship in Bulgarian. Excellent flavor with just the right amount of tart.</p> <p>Yields until frost. Prefers full sun exposure. Yields Until Frost; Prefers Full Sun Exposure</p>
